#### Homily Saints Peter and Paul

Today we celebrate two great pillars of our faith: Saint Peter and Saint Paul: though vastly different in origin and temperament, they were united in one common mission: to proclaim Christ and to build up His Church—even at the cost of their own lives.

Let us begin with Saint Peter, the humble fisherman of Galilee. To him, Jesus said "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church." Saint Peter was not perfect. He was afraid, he fell, he denied the Lord. But Jesus did not choose the most capable—He chose the one who loved Him most. After the Resurrection, Christ did not ask Peter for explanations—He asked only for love: "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" It was this love, united with a repentant heart, that made Peter the visible foundation of the unity of the Church. That is why we recognize in the Pope, Saint Peter's successor, the clear sign of Christ's fidelity to His promise: "The gates of hell shall not prevail against it." And this is why we affirm with all of Tradition: where Peter is, there is the Church. Being with the Pope is more than obedience — it is an act of faith; it is love for Jesus. The Holy Father is our father in the faith, teacher of truth, and shepherd of Christ's flock, even in difficult times.

But today we also celebrate Saint Paul, the Apostle to the Nations. From being a persecutor, he became the most ardent missionary of the Gospel. He teaches us that no one is beyond the reach of grace, and that the love of Christ can transform any heart.

As Pope Benedict XVI once said: "Peter represents the structure of the Church; Paul, her mission in the world." To celebrate Saints Peter and Paul is to renew our communion with the Pope, and to rekindle in ourselves the missionary zeal of Paul. But even more, it is to offer our own lives as living stones in the building up of the Church. May the intercession of these holy apostles rekindle in us the resolve to remain faithful to Christ and to His Church.
