

Homily 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Our first reading today is taken from Moses' farewell discourse to the people of Israel. It is a solemn and loving exhortation to remain faithful to God by keeping His Word. Moses insists that God's Law is not distant or impossible.

This is a beautiful reminder that God is near to us, and that His will is accessible. He speaks to us through Scripture and calls us to live according to His commandments. As St. Paul prays for the Ephesians, so should we pray: "that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened", so that we can understand and embrace His Word.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us of the supreme closeness of God in Jesus Christ. Through the Incarnation, God's eternal Word became flesh and dwelt among us. Christ is the visible image of the invisible God who reconciles all things to Himself. As the Church teaches, in Christ, "God is with us to free us from the darkness of sin and death, and to raise us up to life eternal".

Today's Gospel offers another profound way God draws near to us: in our neighbor. Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan to show that God is present in the needs of others, especially the suffering, the poor, the outcast, and the wounded. The Samaritan's compassion reveals the heart of God Himself, who is rich in mercy.

Pope Francis has often reminded us that "each person is a brother or sister to be loved". To encounter God, we must be willing to cross boundaries, overcome prejudices, and care for those in need. The Good Samaritan is an icon of Christ Himself, who comes to heal our wounds and carry us to safety.

In this way, God is not far off. He is close in His Word, in Christ made flesh, and in every neighbor who needs our help. Truly, as the Psalmist asks: "What great nation is there that has gods so close to it as the Lord our God is to us?".

Let us ask the Holy Spirit today to open our hearts to God's nearness and to empower us to love Him in His Word, in His Son, and in our neighbor.
