Homily 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Word of God proclaimed in today's liturgy invites us to live in a constant state of pilgrimage — as people always ready to meet the Lord Jesus.

In the Second Reading, we hear that living in a state of readiness means living by faith. Faith is not simply belief in something vague or sentimental. As the Letter to the Hebrews tells us, it is "the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen". Faith rests on the Word of God — a word that opens before us a future we cannot yet see. This faith was tested in the lives of Abraham, Sarah, and the people of Israel. Many of them died before entering the Promised Land, but they died trusting in God's promise. They lived as strangers and pilgrims in this world, yearning for "a better homeland — a heavenly one".

This, too, is the Christian vocation: to live as pilgrims and exiles in this world. When we received the Holy Spirit, we were given a foretaste of our true homeland — the Kingdom of Heaven. As St. Paul says, "our citizenship is in heaven". Earth is not our final dwelling. We are passing through, but we do so with meaning, with hope, and with a mission.

In the Gospel, Jesus deepens this teaching. He tells us to be watchful, like servants awaiting their master's return. We are stewards of the gifts God has entrusted to us — our faith, our time, our vocations, our responsibilities. Jesus warns us that much will be required of those to whom much has been given. He may return at any hour, and we are called to be found faithful — not asleep, not distracted, but ready.

Let us then live as true pilgrims — with hearts rooted in heaven, eyes fixed on Christ, and lives marked by faithfulness. May we walk in the footsteps of the saints, who teach us what it means to trust in the promises of God and to live with the hope of eternal life.
